Thank you all for your enquiry about the New Zealand China Friendship Society's Photographers Tour to China.

We are fortunate that NZCFS' very good partners in China, the Chinese Peoples' Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries (Youxie) will once again be our in-China tour providers. This gives us a national level guide with excellent English and international experience, as well as a lot of experience with such tours; and also excellent connections to local Friendship organizations. This tour is specifically for photographers, with a relatively slow pace allowing free time to wander as well as organized visits to a wide range of photography opportunities. For those who are non-photographers, the pace is also attractive with an added bonus of learning some new techniques for taking some spectacular shots.

In the 3 weeks, there will be 5 key locations, with the final 3 destinations in close proximity, so not too much time is lost in travel. Details of the itinerary are continuing to be made, and changes, if any, will be notified as soon as possible.
