## Tour Highlights:

### Nature

- Hukou Pubu, the ‘boiling kettle’ waterfall on the Yellow River
- Huashan - lotus flower peak, with dramatic ‘dragon back’ ridge
- Nature parks and reserves - animals birds, karst sinkhole landscapes
- Li River



### Culture

- Buddhist cliff carvings, Dazu, Chongqing
- Four days on the road from Guizhou to Guangxi through diverse ethnic groups and communities
- “Impressions of Liu Sanjie” show on water, Yangshuo
- Diverse food experiences from north to south



### History

- Pre 1949 revolutionary sites at Yan’an, Shaanxi, and Zunyi, Guizhou
- Plank Road, ancient route from the north to Sichuan
- Missionary Museum, Chengdu
- Old Ming Town of Qingyan, Guiyang
